TEACHER MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

ART

Master's in Fine Arts preferred. BA in fine arts with a master's degree in teaching or education with supplemental experience.

ANATOMY

Same as Biology.

ASTRONOMY

Masters or PhD; Related degrees: Physics, Geology, Atmospheric Science plus 1 year teaching at community college level or higher OR Bachelor's degree in Astronomy or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

BIOLOGY

Master's degree in Biology or related field or Bachelor's degree in Biology or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

BUSINESS

101 & 150

Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Business Education, Economics or Management; and relevant experience and/or education.

201: Master's degree in Business Administration, Management, or Law and relevant experience.

CHEMISTRY

Chem& 121

Bachelor's degree in science, plus two years of college chemistry, including one year of organic chemistry or related experience.

Chem& 161/162 & 200 series

MS in chemistry.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE

Five years law enforcement experience in the last ten years with city, county, state or federal law enforcement agency, and BA/BS degree. Education may be waived with law enforcement experience on a year- for-year basis.

ECONOMICS

Master's degree in Economics or related field with at least 18 quarterly credits in Economics, plus three years of high school or college-level teaching experience. Or Bachelor's in Economics with at least 18 quarterly graduate level credits in Economics plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

EDUCATION

Master's degree in Education or related field, plus teaching experience in this subject matter.

ENGLISH

Master's degree in English or related field, plus experience teaching writing courses OR bachelor's degree in English or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE

Bachelor's degree in an environmentally related science plus a Master's in teaching, education or another science.

GEOLOGY

MA in Geology or related field OR Bachelor's degree in Geology or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

HEALTH PHYSICAL EDUCATION/HEALTH & WELLNESS

For 100 Level courses -

Bachelor's degree in Kinesiology, Exercise Science, Exercise Physiology, Physical Education, or related field.

HISTORY

MA in history or related field OR Bachelor's degree in History or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

HUMANITIES AND ETHNIC STUDIES

MA in Humanities or Humanities related field OR Bachelor's degree in Humanities or Humanities related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

JOURNALISM

Master's degree in Journalism, Mass Communication, or Communication (not Speech Communication), OR Bachelor's degree plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

MATHEMATICS 107, 138, 141/142, and 146

BA or BS in mathematics, or BA in Education with an emphasis on math or successful teaching experience in this subject matter. Master's degree in teaching or education

MATHEMATICS 151 & 152

MA or MS in Mathematics or Math Education or appropriate coursework. OR Bachelor's in Mathematics, Math Education plus Master's degree in teaching or education and two or more year's of teaching Calculus.

PHYSICS

MA or MS degree in physics;and one year teaching experience at college undergraduate level
Two years teaching assistant experience may substitute for one year as an instructor. OR
Bachelor's degree in Physics or related field plus Master's degree in teaching or education.

POLITICAL SCIENCE

Master's in Political Science or related degree OR Bachelor's degree in Political Science plus Master's degree in teaching or education..

PSYCHOLOGY

Master's in psychology.

SPANISH, FRENCH, JAPANESE, RUSSIAN, CHINESE & GERMAN

- Bachelor's degree in target language or related field
- Two years of college-level classroom experience, or equivalent, teaching first- or second-year language.

Teachers without a master's degree will have their credentials and experience reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
