

## **Application for Tuition Reduction for Non-Residents**

A partial tuition reduction of the regular non-resident tuition is allowable for US citizens and permanent residents ("green card" holders), *living in Washington State.* This reduction applies only to the tuition of state-supported classes, effective beginning Fall, 2003. Persons who hold non-immigrant visas <u>do not qualify</u> for this tuition reduction program.

After the 12+ consecutive months in WA State, students who meet state residency requirements may apply for resident (instate) tuition by completing the State Residence Questionnaire and submitting supporting documentation.
