

**Everett Community College does not require a TOEFL or IELTS score.**

If you do not have a TOEFL score you will be given an English placement test before registering for classes. Students whose test results show skills adequate for college work will be excused from our English Preparation Program. Others will be required to take Intensive and Advanced English classes until the language requirement has been met for English 101.
