

Thank you for your interest in Everett Community College's Student Housing for your upcoming Internship! Please see the below frequently asked questions!

What are the costs associated with Student Housing?

All housing residents can expect to see the following fees:

\$300 Administration Fee: A one time fee used to cover the cleaning of your unit after moving out

\$200 Application Fee: This covers your background check and other costs associated with applying for student housing

\$200 Refundable Security Deposit: This is held in the event there are damages to the unit. It will be returned 6 weeks after you move out if no damages occur.

Rent: We only charge rent for the dates you will be living in Housing, this number changes depending on the timeline of your internship. Internships beginning earlier (May-June) will have higher housing costs than later starts (July-August). This is to align with Housing's charge structure for EvCC Students. **If you are in need of an estimate, please provide your anticipated Move in and Move out dates to Housing@everettcc.edu**

How do I apply for Housing?

Please fill out our [Summer Intern Application](#). If you are unsure of your exact housing dates, please provide us with your best guess, and be sure to update housing staff as soon as your dates are set so we can adjust your cost estimate.

How do I move in to Student Housing?

Once your application has been processed, we will contact you via email with your housing assignment and instructions to set up an appointment to pick up your keys. This appointment must occur Monday-Thursday between the hours of 8am and 4pm. Move-ins prior to June 17th may also occur on Fridays.

How do I pay for Student Housing?

If you have previously lived in housing for an internship, charges will be posted to your ctclink ID and payment can be made online.

If you have not lived in housing for an internship, payment will be made in person to our cashiers office as a departmental receipt. You will receive more information regarding this process prior to your move in date.

What if I have a car on campus?

Parking passes are available to purchase through our campus security office. Upon Move in, you will receive a form to input your vehicle's information, after which you will take the form to the Cashiers office, make payment and then the Campus Security Office to show the receipt and pick up a permit.

Street parking along 10th street is available without a permit, but is often limited and is enforced by the City of Everett.
