

# Guide to Articulation (Transfer) Agreements

*This Guide provides information about the wide variety of transfer and articulation agreements between Everett Community College and other colleges and universities. The agreements are formed to help students transfer to or from Everett Community College. Please work with an advisor.*



In general there are two types of university transfer options for EvCC graduates.

1. Everett Community College offers several associate degrees that are focused on transferability to universities:

- Associate in Arts and Sciences-DTA (AAS-DTA) (formerly known as AAS Option II)
- Associate in Business (AB)
- Associate of Applied Science – Transfer (AAS-T)
- Associate in Technology- DTA
- Associate of Science DTA/MRP (AS)
- Associate in Pre-Nursing (DTA/MRP)

A. Most universities in Washington have formally agreed to take these degrees as a “package” that meets most or all of the lower division general education requirements at the university. B. Under Intercollege Relations Commission Guidelines, students who earn the AAS-DTA degree and meet the minimum grade point average required by the transfer institution will have completed the lower division general education requirements and can usually transfer with Junior standing to :

C. Some of these degrees are formulated to include prerequisites for some specialized majors, such as business, engineering, and some sciences.

D. Some of the colleges and universities not aligned with ICRC have also entered into transfer agreements with Everett Community College for students who have these degrees. These agreements are listed in the chart on the next several pages.

2. Several other associate degrees at EvCC have limited transferability, though in some cases there is an explicit transfer pathway as outlined in an agreement with an institution listed in the chart on the next several pages.

- Associate in Technical Arts (ATA)
- Associate in General Studies (AGS)
