****Remember**, you have to meet with your high school counselor **BEFORE** you register for your college classes, so contact your high school counselor **now** to make an advising appointment with them.

Pay attention to what's going on at your high school. Are there dates to be aware of? Appointments to keep? Deadlines to watch for? Senior project details can sneak up on you! Stay in touch with your high school counselor and don't miss out!

2009 Seniors take note!

I know it's hard to think about life after senior year, but its coming! University application deadlines for Fall 2009 are fast approaching. If the deadline has passed, contact the admission office at the university for information about late applications.

University of Washington – December 1
Western Washington Univ – March 1 (Dec 1 for housing)
Washington State Univ – January 31
Eastern Washington Univ – March 1
Central Washington Univ – April 7

Keep in mind when applying to university after your senior year, you will be applying as a Freshman, and following all rules and deadlines that apply to freshman applications. You will still get to transfer any credits you have earned here, but freshman application deadlines and rules are different, so do your research.

Don't forget to explore Financial Aid! 2009-2010 applications are available as of January 1, 2009. Apply even if you think you don't qualify – you could be pleasantly surprised. Ask in the Financial Aid office (3rd Floor Parks Building) for more information.

SENIORS - Are you finishing an AA degree or other degree or certificate this spring? Make

sure you apply to the Enrollment Services office by **February 6**. You will need to have an application signed by an EvCC faculty member, and a completed degree checklist. If you have any questions, be sure to ask! If you are late with the application, better late than never – get it in!

Have you tried an online class? These are great opportunities to utilize technology, but don't assume that they are an easier choice! Online classes require discipline, commitment, and self-motivation. If you want more information about online classes, contact the distance learning office at 425-388-9367.

\$\$\$\$ **Don't forget** – Running Start **WON'T** pay for classes numbered under 100, like Math 081, 090, or 099! If you register for those, you WILL owe tuition for them! If the Enrollment Services person registering you forgets, you need to make sure it says you owe money.
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Do you know your Student Number? It begins with 80...if you don't know, stop by Enrollment Services with photo id, and we'd be happy to give it to you. You can use your Student number to go online to view your transcript in the student kiosk.

Important Dates to Remember

February 6 – Deadline to apply for your EvCC degree in Enrollment Services.

February 20 – Class Schedules arrive on campus and in your home mail box.

February 24 – Advising Day 11 AM – 12:45 PM, Jackson Center. This is a great opportunity to talk with college faculty prior to registration for Spring Quarter.

February 25 – Current students begin registering for Spring Quarter by appointment only. Check the Student kiosk for your time to register!

February 27 – Last day to withdraw from class for Winter with a W on your transcript.

March 12 – Deadline to pay for Winter Quarter tuition and fees.

March 13 – No registration services available that day.

March 17 - 20 – Finals week for Winter Quarter. Check your class syllabus for finals dates, times and locations.

March 21-30 – Spring Break

March 26 – Grades will be posted to transcripts and sent to high school registrar's offices.

March 30 – Spring Quarter Classes begin.

April 3 – Last day to add classes without instructor permission.

April 10 – Last day to add or drop classes with no record.

Look ahead to summer 2009 – Running Start does not pay tuition during the summer, but there are plenty of classes available, and you are eligible to attend. It might be a good way to catch up on some college credits.
