I know it's hard to think about life after senior year, but its coming! University application deadlines for Fall 2010 are fast approaching. If you know where you want to go, be sure to have all your application materials submitted by that school's deadline.

**University of Washington** – December 1  
**Western Washington University** – March 1  
**Washington State University** – January 31  
**Eastern Washington University** – March 1  
**Central Washington University** – April 1  
**Evergreen State College** – March 1

Keep in mind when applying to university after your senior year, you will be applying as a **Freshman**, and following all rules and deadlines that apply to freshman applications. You will still get to transfer any credits you have earned here, but freshman application deadlines and rules are different, so do your research.

September 2 – No registration transactions.

September 25 – Last day to register without instructor permission/Last day for 100% tuition refund.  
October 2 – Last day to change your schedule with no record.  
October 30 – Winter quarter schedule on campus  
November 1 – Winter Quarter Deadline for **NEW RUNNING START STUDENT APPLICATIONS**  
November 3 – No classes.  
November 6 – **WINTER QUARTER REGISTRATION BEGINS CURRENT STUDENTS ONLY!**  
November 11 – Veteran's Day. College Closed.  
November 13 – Last day to withdraw with a "W" grade.  
November 26 – No Classes.  
November 27-28 – Thanksgiving Holiday. College Closed.  
December 4 – Last day of Classes.  
December 7-10 – Finals Week.  
December 10 – Deadline to pay for **WINTER QUARTER**.  
December 11 – No registration services available.  
December 18 – Fall Grades posted to transcripts.
