

If students cannot attend the scheduled College in the High School testing sessions or those students who scored 45 or below **on the ASSET Test** and wish to re-test by taking the Compass test should follow these instructions:

Students can take the Compass test at the EvCC testing center and try to qualify but they must do so before the registration deadline. **The minimum score on the writing portion of the Compass Test is 82** and the student will receive their score at the end of the testing session.

- Students must first find parking. Parking on campus is extremely challenging and all parking is **pay** parking:
Students may park in Visitor parking and pay \$1 for two hours at the yellow pay station on the south side of the Parks Student Union Building. Or students may park in student parking and purchase a one-day pass for \$1 at the Cashier's Office located in the Jackson Center.
- Once parked and properly permitted, students need to go to the Jackson Center Cashier, identify themselves as a College in the High School student (otherwise the Cashier will charge them \$25) and pay \$10 to take the Compass.
- Take the receipt back to the Parks Student Union Building, third floor testing center.
- Identify themselves to the Testing Center staff as College in the High School and fill out or bring with them the Release of Information form (so the Testing Center will share with me their scores. This form is available on the website.
- I suggest students arrive 45-60 minutes before the scheduled start time.
