Search Tips

Feature	Sample Search	Finds
AND	election AND bush	documents that contain both the words <i>election</i> and <i>bush</i>
OR	revolution OR uprising	documents that contain <u>either</u> the word <i>revolution</i> or the word <i>uprising</i>
NOT	protest NOT war	documents that contain the word <i>protest</i> but not the word <i>war</i>
W#	president W3 election	documents with the word <i>president</i> occurring before the word <i>election</i> and within 3 words of the word <i>election</i>
N#	president N4 election	documents with the words <i>president</i> and <i>election</i> in any order within 4 words of each other
“ “	“new zealand”	documents that contain the phrase <i>new zealand</i>
?	wom?n	documents that contain either the words <i>woman</i> or <i>women</i> or <i>womyn</i> ; the ? represents one character and can be used within a word or at the end of a word
*	president*	documents that contain any words beginning with the letters president-, such as <i>president</i> , <i>presidents</i> , <i>presidential</i> ; the * represents any number of characters and can only be used at the end of a word
()	(war* OR battle OR uprising) AND (wom?n OR children)	documents that contain at least one of the words <i>war</i> , <i>wars</i> , <i>wartime</i> , <i>warfare</i> , <i>battle</i> , or <i>uprising</i> <u>and</u> at least one of the words <i>woman</i> , <i>women</i> , or <i>children</i> ; the () are used to clarify how you want a complicated search statement to run

Specialized Searches

Person: Search for a historical figure by name, profession, nationality, birth or death year, birth place, or gender.

Subject: Search for a topic and receive suggestions for related topics.

Advanced: Limit a search to a particular field (title, author, etc.) of the document's record, historical time period, date of publication, or document type.
