# JSTOR

**JSTOR** is a database of full-text journal articles in the arts and sciences. Unlike most of the other library databases, JSTOR is archival in nature: it includes articles, sometimes dating back to the 1800s, from the very first volumes of journals. Due to publisher restrictions, the most current issues of each journal are not available.

## Accessing JSTOR

From any computer with Internet access, go to the library database page <http://www.everettcc.edu/library/index.cfm?id=5782> and click on the link to JSTOR. (Off-campus users will be prompted for their EvCC student or staff ID number.)

## Searching

JSTOR can be browsed by journal title or searched. JSTOR automatically opens to the basic search page. The tips below apply to the **advanced search**.
