Other Books and Videos

➤ To find works by Shakespeare, including his plays on video, in the library catalog do an **author search** for Shakespeare or a **title browse search** for the name of the play.

➤ To find works about Shakespeare or about his plays, do a **subject browse search** for Shakespeare.
