

Students of Color Career Conference Scholarship

Academic Year 2010-2011

This scholarship is made possible by funding from Reed Consulting, Inc. (RCI), an accounting services and personal finance organization; and by the friends of RCI. This scholarship is available for a student of color who meets the criteria below and will attend any accredited university, college, community or technical college in the United States. The amount of the scholarship award is **\$1,000.00** and funds must be used for tuition, fees, books, premium for health insurance provided through the higher education institution, and/or on-campus room and board (fraternity, sorority and campus dorms). All payments will be made directly to the educational institution enrolled (under no circumstances will payment be made directly to the student).

Criteria for Selection

- 1. Must be a Senior in a Snohomish County High School;**
- 2. Must be a Person of Color;**
- 3. Must have a GPA between 2.0 and 3.2 on a 4.0 scale;**
- 4. Must attend the Snohomish County Students of Color Career Conference on January 15, 2010 AND be present to win.**

Application Requirements

- 1. Completed Scholarship Application (see below).**
- 2. A 500 word written essay (preferably typed) and double spaced, on the topic, "My Dream and My Plan to Achieve It." Also include in your essay any unique circumstance and/or hardships/obstacles that you have overcome.** All materials should be submitted to your high school counselor by **December 11**. High School counselors, please submit to Janice Lovelace, EvCC, Parks Bldg, 318, by Monday, December 14. All applicants will be notified at the Students of Color Career Conference on January 15th.
