# 1. INTRODUCTION

Medical emergencies with known and unknown causes can occur without warning to students, staff, and visitors on campus. A timely, trained response is the best chance for recovery.

# 2. **RESPONSE GUIDELINES**

#### A. Life Threatening Emergency

- Call 9-1-1. Advise the emergency operator of the circumstances and follow the instructions given.
- Either call or send a runner to the Campus Security Office.
- State the medical aid needed.
- Provide the location of the emergency.
- Describe the type of injury or illness.
- Provide a brief description of how the injury or illness occurred.
- Do not move the injured or ill person unless it is necessary to avoid further injury. Have someone meet the responding unit(s) and direct them to the emergency.

#### **B. Non-Life Threatening Need for Medical Assistance**

- Call Campus Security
- State the medical aid needed
- Provide the location of the emergency
- Describe the type of injury or illness
- Provide a brief description of how the injury or illness occurred
- Do not move the injured or ill person unless it is necessary to avoid further injury
- Have someone meet the responding Security Officer to direct him or her to the emergency location

# TABLE 1-A "Guideline for Managing

Medical/Trauma Incidents"

The following is a guideline for managing med/trauma scenes. Each situation presents a different set of circumstances so no guideline can be followed mechanically. The purpose of this outline is to provide a framework to provide a standardized approach to assessment and problem solving.

Size-Up	Environmental Scan
	Scene Observations
Hazard Assessment	Danger to Self / Danger to Others / Danger to Victim
Patient Contact	<ul> <li>Gain control of the scene</li> <li>Introduce yourself – Identify why you are there</li> <li>Request permission if doing any type of examination</li> </ul>
Primary Survey	<ul> <li>Survey Patient for immediate actions:</li> <li>Airway – Breathing - Circulation</li> <li>Bleeding</li> <li>Severe Shock</li> <li>Spinal Precautions if indicated</li> </ul>
Establish Command	Establish/assume command if indicated; "Unit 5 – Establishing Olympus Command"
Triage Multiple Patients	<ul> <li>Triage all patients if indicated – typically only "Primary Survey"</li> <li>Classify using the "START" system</li> </ul>
Secondary Survey	SUBJECTIVE "Symptoms" : What You Are Told
	<ul> <li>History? Recent events?</li> <li>What happened – precipitated event?</li> <li>Level of consciousness / Orientation (person, place, time)</li> <li>Situational Awareness / Tracking</li> </ul>
	OBJECTIVE "Signs": "What you can directly observe"
	<ul> <li>Examples: Skin, Pupils, Pulse, Respirations, Bleeding, Deformities, marks/wounds, etc.</li> </ul>
	Most patients should get a "Head-to-Toe" examination
Assessment	What you determine may be the problem based on the Signs & Symptoms
Plan	How will you manage this situation?
