

EVCC Mathematics Placement Grid via WA High School Transcripts

Students may use either the letter grade earned in the **second** term of a high school mathematics course from any homeschool or high school in the USA, a Math GED test score, or their overall cumulative high school GPA to determine their mathematics placement at Everett Community College. Grades and scores must be from within the last **five** years.

Notes:

- Only Second term grades of completed classes are required for placement, but beginning in mid-March, for current class, first term grades *may* be used, along with a progress report of their second term, for placement.
- Any high school courses with a grade of S (satisfactory) or P (passing), placement will be based on the “C or higher” placement.
- For any course, grade, or GPA not covered above, mathematics placement is determined by placement test.
- Placement via cumulative GPA is only available for students who have graduated from high school within the last 5 years
