

A fee waiver is available for College in the High School (CHS) students that qualify. Eligible students can waive up to two 5-credit CHS courses per year for a total of \$440. To be eligible, students need to currently attend a high school in the Everett Community College Service District (Snohomish County) and meet at least one of the criteria below. Students must provide verification and the student's name must appear on any documentation provided.

___ Student has been deemed eligible for free-reduced-price lunches (FRPL) for the current school year. *Please attach a copy of the school district FRPL verification letter.*

___ Currently receiving any state or federal assistance funds.
Please attach a copy of the DSHS award letter verifying eligibility for TANF or Basic Food/EBT "Quest" Card/SNAP benefits, Apple Health card and photo ID, HUD Housing Award letter, or Medical Identification Card (medical coupon).

Fee waivers are good for one academic year and are not retroactive. Students must reapply for the waiver each academic year that they are participating in CHS. This waiver does not affect any other dual credit program that a student may be enrolled in at Everett Community College.

Provide the required documentation and request form to the CHS office by the deadline. Visit our CHS Dates and Deadlines page at EverettCC.edu/CHS. Email the form and documentation to collegeinhs@everettcc.edu. Requests without documentation will not be processed. Documentation without a signed request will not be processed. Late requests will not be processed.
