The goal of Everett Community College is to encourage student success in mathematics. Realistic placement is critical for a student's success. In place of COMPASS and ASSET assessments, students may be placed according to the following chart:

NOTE: Students who have earned a C or lower in their last math class or who do not qualify for another reason using the chart below, must be placed by COMPASS or ASSET.

| Algebra <br> II/Trigonometry | B or better | One Year | Math\& 141* |
| Honors Algebra <br> Trigonometry | B or better | One Year | Math\& 141* |

* Math\& 141, 142, and 151 require significant time and effort, often more than the minimum of 10 hours of out of class study time per week.
