The goal of Everett Community College is to encourage student success in mathematics. Realistic placement is critical for a student's success. In place of COMPASS and ASSET assessments, students may be placed according to the following chart:

NOTE: Students who have earned a C or lower in their last math class or who do not qualify for another reason using the chart below, must be placed by COMPASS or ASSET.

If your last math course was	and you earned a grade of 	and completed that course within	your placement will be
Pre-calculus	B- or better	One or Two Years	Math& 151
Algebra II	B- or better	One or Two Years	Math& 141

NOTE: Students in Math Proficiency I/II should use COMPASS/ASSET or highest math class taken prior to that course.

^{*} Math& 151 & 152 require significant time and effort, often more than the minimum of 10 hours of out of class study time per week.
