For College the High School Program Course

The goal of Everett Community College is to encourage student success in mathematics. Realistic placement is critical for a student's success. In place of COMPASS and ASSET assessments, students may be placed according to the following chart:

*NOTE: Students who have earned a C or lower in their last math class or who do not qualify for another reason using the chart below, must be placed by COMPASS or ASSET.*

<i>If your last math course was ...</i>	<i>and you earned a grade of ...</i>	<i>and completed that course within</i>	<i>your placement will be ...</i>
Pre-calculus	B- or better	One or Two Years	Math& 151
Algebra II	B- or better	One or Two Years	Math& 141

NOTE: Students in Math Proficiency I/II should use COMPASS/ASSET or highest math class taken prior to that course.

\* Math& 151 & 152 require significant time and effort, often more than the minimum of 10 hours of out of class study time per week.
