NOTE: Students who have earned a C or lower in their last math class or who do not qualify for another reason using the chart below, must be placed by COMPASS or ASSET.

|------------------------------------|-------------------------------------|---|----------------------------|
| Algebra II | B- or better | One or Two Years | Math& 141, Math& 107 |
| Pre Calculus | C or better | One or Two Years | Math& 107 |

NOTE: Students in Math Proficiency I/II should use COMPASS/ASSET or highest math class taken prior to that course.

^{*} Math& 141, 142, and 151 require significant time and effort, often more than the minimum of 10 hours of out of class study time per week.
