## **Washington State Dependent Residency for Tuition Worksheet**

Residency for tuition purposes is determined by the information you provide on your admission application. To apply for reclassification as a resident, students must be able to document their intent to establish Washington as their permanent domicile (home/residence) at least 12 months prior to the official first day of the quarter for which they are applying.

<u>DEADLINE:</u> Residence Questionnaire form and all supporting documentation must be received by the **30<sup>th</sup> calendar day of the quarter** for which you are applying. Documents received after the 30<sup>th</sup> calendar day will be considered for the following quarter. We cannot process any residency adjustments for previous quarters.

This worksheet is for students that are Dependent following the guidelines of RCW 28B.15.012. Residency for Financially Dependent students looks to the domicile of their parents or legal, court appointed documents.

ent Signature Date	PRESUMPTION OF MOVE TO WASHINGTON FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES  If you (or your parent/legal guardian) attended a Washington institution for more than six (6) hours per semester or quarter any time during the twelve (12) months in which you are establishing residency, state law presumes the move to the state to be primarily for educational purposes. Therefore, if driver's license and vehicle registration are less than 12 months old or you do not have one, you will be required to submit documentation proving that move is not for educational purposes.
