

# Register for continuing education classes

## Where to start

Applying for admissions to the college is not necessary if you only want to enroll in continuing education courses or training programs through the Corporate & Continuing Education Center (CCEC). ## Create or update your account

- For a new account, enter a desired username, password and current email address and select "Create account." Fill out the profile form using your personal information. Please remember to enter your student ID if you already have one, and then select "submit."
- Once you have created an account, you will not need to do it again. You can use it to log in and register and pay for new classes, and to view your current classes, transcripts, and transaction receipts at any time.
