Principles of Phlebotomy for Nursing

Health Sciences is partnering with the Nursing program to offer a special 4- credit Phlebotomy class exclusively for EvCC Nursing Students.

Learning Objectives:

1. Evaluate the venipuncture processes to obtain venous blood samples utilizing:
a) evacuated blood collecting systems,
b) syringes, and c) capillary punctures.
2. Discuss blood specimen handling, processing, preanalytical errors, and transportation.
3. Evaluate quality control practices to ensure specimen integrity.
4. Evaluate documentation requirements for venipuncture procedures.
