PrepU:

PrepU is an adaptive quizzing engine that offers NCLEX-style questions which are customized for your level of understanding and challenges you at an appropriate pace and difficulty level. "Mastery Levels" (1 is the lowest and 8 is the highest) are assigned as students answer more difficult questions and demonstrate greater mastery on course concepts.

The PrepU adaptive system will grade your quiz, analyze your performance and calculate your overall mastery level. Your quiz results include your answer and the correct answer, a rationale as to why the correct answer is correct and a "Smart-Sense link" which redirects you to the location in the e-book where that concept is presented.






PrepU Best Practices





vSim Best Practices:


